From the Farmers...

Last weekend the winter squash was seeded, the second planting of squash, melons, cucumbers, tomatoes, and peppers were all placed in their summer homes. We will be planting the sweet potatoes this week, hopefully they will have time to grow...they are a long season crop and we are just on the northern fringe of their growing zone. We get the plants from a southern grower every year and this season he was a little behind in his harvesting...so we will be getting them in the ground two weeks later than usual.

We are feeling pretty good about the state of our crops this year. Everything was in the ground on time and we have been able to not get too far behind in the weeding and maintenance of those crops. Our only regret this

season was taking our first planting of squash and cukes out of the greenhouse too early. It suffered then and it is still suffering from the cool temperatures it was exposed too early in its life. So they will not be here until July. The peas and strawberries should be coming on strong this week; the cooler temperatures should keep them from all ripening at once.
